Presentation formats

Podium: Podium presentations will be 30 minutes in length followed by a 10 minute audience discussion.

Poster: Poster presentations will be featured at the conference wine and cheese reception.

Panel: Panel presentations will include five participants. Each will have 15 minutes to discuss his/her classroom/curriculum approach to Reflective Practice. There will be a 15 minute audience dialogue following the panel presentation.

Abstract requirements

The abstract should include the title and focus of the presentation. Briefly summarize the content and key learning objectives. The abstract should be no longer than 300 words and submitted in electronic MS Word format. Please identify A-V equipment required. Please provide a brief personal biography.

Abstract submission process

All submitted abstracts will be acknowledged by the selection committee. Abstracts will be submitted to a peer review panel. The process will be completed by February 15, 2008. Authors will be informed of the outcome by February 17, 2008. Successful authors must inform the committee of their intent to present by February 28, 2008 to be included in the conference brochure. All presenters must register for the conference and are responsible for any personal expenses.
